Services Delayed Due to Extreme Temperatures Forecasted

(Corpus Christi, Texas) – Due to extreme weather conditions forecasted by the National Weather Service (NWS) and local Emergency Operations Centers (EOC), all CCRTA service including B-Line Paratransit, will begin at 12:00pm on Tuesday, January 21st.

CCRTA's Customer Service Center will also be closed until 12:00pm.

CCRTA will continue to work with local EOCs to provide transportation to and from warming centers.
